Sheffield City Region 'on the up'

Welcome to The Star / Barber Harrison & Platt 2014 Top 100 Companies survey for the Sheffield City Region (SCR).

This year we have widened the geographical remit of the survey to include all of the SCR (it previously focused on South Yorkshire and North East Derbyshire). To allow for this I have only analysed sector changes based on the performance of the companies featured in this year's survey in 2014 and 2013, i.e. on a like for like basis.

The headline results for the SCR survey show:

- turnover across the Top 100 companies has grown by 2.7% compared to last year
- pre-tax results have moved from an aggregate loss of £96m to a profit of £500m
- employee numbers have grown by around 4%.

Looking into the detail, the survey shows that Manufacturing remains the largest sector in the Top 100 for the fourth year running, in spite of a small dip in both turnover and profits during the period. Within this sector, Metals companies appear to have suffered most from declining results in a challenging environment. Interestingly, the combined turnover of the featured manufacturers which specifically supply to the "Building Products and Construction" industry has increased by 69% over the last year. This supports the growth seen by the

construction businesses featured in the survey. After years of malaise, a buzz is returning to this sector alongside a welcome return to profits.

The Service sector is of particular note, accounting for 25% of the total combined turnover of the businesses featured, with the Food and Drink industry showing the greatest growth, whilst the IT, Motor and Transport industries are also doing well.

The seven Retail companies in the survey have together achieved 14% growth in turnover over the last year and represent the most profitable sector featured in the survey. This is impressive as Retail has faced huge challenges over the last few years. In fact it is testament to how much things have changed that five of these companies now have strong online


trading arms and consequently have been able to become, or retain their status as, household names.

In summary, the survey's results show that, in spite of recent challenging times, more of our region's companies are thriving, facilitating both job creation and investment in future growth.


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Top 100 at a glance 2014

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M&A back on the corporate agenda

After a period of prolonged stagnation the general consensus seems to be that 2014 will be the year that mergers and acquisitions ["M&A"] will again feature at or near the top of corporate agendas. The conditions for renewed M&A activity do indeed appear to be sound; increasing boardroom confidence, substantial cash piles on balance sheets, improving credit liquidity and a push for growth post-recession all bode well for future transaction volume.

Not that our region's Top 100 companies have been shying away from dealmaking in the past 12 months. Of particular note is the recent influence of the public markets on our largest corporates with December seeing Sheffield software and controls systems specialist Servelec complete a £120 million initial public offering (IPO) as it spun-out of Singaporean parent CSE Global.

More recently Doncaster headquartered plastic piping manufacturer Polypipe returned to the stock market in an IPO that valued the business at £490 million. Polypipe was first listed on the stock exchange in 1986 and remained in public ownership until it was acquired by IMI plc in 1999. The business subsequently went through a series of private equity backed transactions culminating in Cavendish Partners' flotation in April. Proof that if you wait long enough, sooner or later everything comes back into fashion.

With the current low interest, low inflation environment and strong investor confidence, IPOs are likely to remain an attractive exit option for private equity investors. With around 15% of the Top 100 having some form of private equity backing, it would not be surprising to see further public market activity in 2014.

Outside of the public arena a good number of the region's largest private companies have been on the acquisition trail. Legal heavyweight Irwin Mitchell continued its buy and build strategy with the acquisitions of MPH Solicitors and HL Interactive. Irwin Mitchell has now chalked up five acquisitions in the past 18 months and the recent news that it has raised $\pounds 60$ million of new facilities suggests that this is a trend that is likely to continue.

Other noteworthy deals within the Top 100 included Underwood Meat's acquisition of sausage manufacturer Bramley Foods, Stafforce Personnel's purchase of Trinity



Recruit and Insight Direct's acquisition of German IT reseller Inmac. Looking at BHP's own pipeline, after a successful 2013 we expect to see deal activity increase further in the next 12 months as more of the region's businesses have the confidence to grow by acquisition.

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Tax planning... there I've said it!

Two words that now seem to be the elephant in every corporate boardroom following Jimmy Carr, Starbucks, Amazon, and the Treasury Select Committee chaired by the evangelical Margaret Hodge MP.

Yes I agree that tax avoidance should be viewed as an elephant – after all you'll know a tax avoidance scheme when you see one, just like you'd recognise an elephant – but tax planning is about forming a plan and strategy for your future tax liabilities which supports your commercial objectives rather than frustrating them.

The BHP Top 100 companies for 2014 include businesses from a wide range of industries and sectors but I'll bet a penny to your pound that all have included some element of tax discussion in their corporate plan, and have considered at least some or even all of the following.

The introduction of Financial Reporting Standard 102, or New UK GAAP as I call it, fundamentally changes the way in which many businesses report and are taxed on their profits. It is important that you are aware how this could affect your tax payments.

Couple this with the fact that profitable businesses can be required to pay their tax bills in instalments during the accounts year rather than after and a growing business may very quickly end up with a serious downturn in its cash flows at a time when cash is king......all this despite the fact that we are nearing the time when our main rate of corporation tax is to become only 20%.

Managing that cash flow is the key to both the investment and innovation required to take a business forward. In support of this the recent Budget confirmed that the Annual Investment Allowance for tax relief on expenditure on plant and machinery is increased to £500,000 until 31 December 2015 - 99% of businesses should now get full tax relief immediately.

The enhanced tax relief for qualifying expenditure on research and development continues to be available to both large and small companies and can result in as much as another 225% of tax relief for every qualifying £1 spent. If you're lucky your technology will even fit in the Patent Box which from 1 April 2017 could see your

profits taxed at as low as 10%.

So come on, kick that elephant out of the Boardroom and make sure that commercial tax planning and strategy appears on your next corporate agenda.

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
