Yorkshire Three Peaks Challenge

By far the largest fundraising effort of the year was the BHP Yorkshire Three Peaks Challenge in May 2022.

Fifty five members of the BHP team climbed the three peaks of Whernside (736m or 2,415ft), Ingleborough (723m or 2,372ft) and Pen-y-ghent (694m or 2,277ft), raising a magnificent, combined total of **£20,381** for their chosen charities.
